2019 CLASS PLACEMENT PROCESS

We are on right on track with our 2019 class placement process. We have had input from teachers and students and parents and are now at the final stages of the process.

- Week 4 -7 - Class placement process –developing classes for 2019.
- Classes finalised week 8 – final brokering (Principal / Deputy Principal and relevant parties)
- Parents informed Thursday Week 9
- Students visit classrooms Friday AM Week 9

When structuring our classes, we work to guidelines and regulations which include;

Starting classes at or below 30 students from year 3 to year 7, and at or below 26 for reception to year 1. We also need to ensure we have the right number of classes according to what we are funded through our enrolment figures.

Our enrolments, cohort numbers and class size restrictions then determine the makeup of classes into composite or straight year levels. This year we have had 17 straight year level classes and 7 composite classes. In 2019 there will be 13 straight year level classes and 11 composite classes.
