PRINCPAL REPORT

Capital Works Funding - \$5 million upgrade for Belair **Primary School**

Fantastic news! \$5 million funding has been approved for our school as part of the Department for Education's Capital Works Program. Planning for our redevelopment project is about to commence.

The key focus of the program is to provide learning areas more suited for the delivery of contemporary pedagogy in order to improve learning outcomes for our students. This may include some or all of:

- demolition of aged relocatable accommodation
- buildings to provide additional accommodation
- refurbishment of existing infrastructure to provide flexible, contemporary learning spaces
- improved street presence and connectivity to the community to make a positive statement about public education.

It is expected that architectural services will be engaged during term 3 2020.

As the project progresses, the concept design will be developed and the program for delivery will be established by the design team. We will be involved throughout the course of the project to ensure that the project delivered meets our school's aspirations.
