Our Program

Meal-time Information

- We will provide hot breakfast till 7:50am and cereal till 8:00am.
- We provide afternoon tea (This is not a substitute for lunch.).
- We encourage families to make healthy choices when providing lunch and recess.
- Due to occupational health and safety regulations, we are unable to heat your child's food. We are a No Nut Products OSHC due to food allergies.

Cancellation Policy

Notification of Cancellation for any vacation care days must be made one week prior to the day that has been booked e.g. cancel a Monday session by 8am previous Monday. All cancellations made after this date will incur a full fee.

If a child is absent due to illness and a doctor's certificate is supplied, a booking will be cancelled.

Medication Policy Requirements

If your child has a medical condition, a Health Care Plan must be provided and medical forms must be completed for each child with a medical condition before they can attend OSHC.

Call or email OSHC to check if your child's medical forms are up to date at OSHC.

Medication (prescribed, non-prescribed, over the counter and natural therapies – vitamins, minerals & supplements) can't be administered by OSHC staff without written advice on a Medication Agreement form (exceptions for asthma & anaphylaxis) & can only be administered by staff with completed Medication Record. Medication must be in its original container, in date & labelled with a pharmacy label that includes the name of the child, the dose to be given & the time(s) to administer it.

'To be taken as required' or similar does not provide enough information & can't be administered by staff. Exceptions are for asthma & anaphylaxis. Children cannot be given a first dose of a new medication at the OSHC service.

Medications must be handed to a staff member.

Clothing

- Please ensure your child is clothed appropriately for exploring and playing freely. No tank tops and sleeveless tops.
- Please ensure your child wears appropriate footwear that enables them to play comfortably and safely.
- No thongs, Crocs or backless shoes.
- Bring labelled spare clothes.
- Please ensure your child is wearing sunscreen.
- Each child needs to wear their **yellow OSHC hat.**

Changes to Program

- Where possible, families will be notified of any changes to the Vacation Care Program e.g. excursions.
- Excursions programmed on days declared as Total Fire Ban in the Mt Lofty Ranges will be cancelled and an alternative program will be run on site.
- On days declared Catastrophic Fire Danger, the Vacation Care Program will be cancelled.
